Warm days & cool nights. The leaves are starting to turn. Autumn has arrived.

As normal, the Borough will be picking up leaves & lawn debris on Wednesdays. This is being done to avoid burning. Please call the Sewer Plant 899-7436 to let them know you have a pick-up.

If you want to dump your own lawn debris up at the water tower, you will need a key for the gate. This site is only for Borough residents and only for lawn debris or leaves. So, if you need a key to get in, call the Borough Office, Keith Gruber, Roland Fagan, Steve Feathers or Pete Sunderland.

If you burn, use a burn barrel & ONLY paper not garbage, food scraps, plastic, etc. Remember you might live near someone who is elderly or has breathing problems. Be Considerate.

Living in a small community like McVeytown means being considerate of your neighbors. So, keep your yard mowed, sidewalk clear, trees or bushes not hanging over the sidewalk, etc.

Permits

Have a question about a building permit, assessment or zoning? The project minimum is \$3,000 but call John Hendricks 899-5108 he can let you know exactly what is needed.

Please remember we have zoning and if you are in a residential area and want to open a business you will need a zoning permit.

Ordinances

It's 10 p.m., do you know where your children are? The curfew ordinance is still in the works but the siren is installed.

Beginning October 6, 2014, the siren will sound at 9:45 p.m. as a warning. It will again go off at 10 p.m. indicating the curfew is in effect.

Council will be reviewing the sidewalk ordinance for sidewalks that are out of compliance. If you have a bad sidewalk, consider repairing or improving it before Council has to take action. Be aware, if someone falls on a sidewalk that is out of compliance, you could be held liable.

McVeytown Borough Authority

Did you know that if you don't pay your water & sewer bill on time that a late charge of \$6.31 is added the first month. Then, another late charge is added for the 2nd month and a late charge will add for each month delinquent. So, at the time of the next quarterly bill, late charges are in excess of \$18.00.

Recently received a late payment from a resident that started as a minimum billing of \$126.20 and by the time it was paid, late charges were \$27.00. That is almost 20% of the total bill. Banks don't pay that kind of interest! Please pay your bill on time!
